In 2021, the Every Child a Swimmer legislation was passed in the State of Florida. This legislation requires all schools in the state to provide parents with information on the importance of water safety and local options for swim lessons as well as how to receive lessons at a free or reduced cost.





WHO HAS ADOPTED THIS LEGISLATION?


Florida enacted the Every Child a Swimmer legislation in 2021.

Arkansas and Georgia adopted the same legislation; Governor's Brain Kemp and Sarah Huckabee Sanders signed the bill in 2023.

SWIMMING SCHOLARSHIPS

ECAS offers free swimming lessons for children from underserved communities. In order to receive scholarships, parents must provide financial information. Our program provides up to 3 months of free lessons per recipient.
